TOTAL OF 2 PERFORMANCES

All classes EXCEPT the preschool classes will perform in BOTH SHOWS as dances are spaced and choreographed for each item.

Preschool Dancers:

Thursday Morning and Afternoon Classes Show 1: 1pm Tuesday and Wednesday Classes Show 2: 4pm

These students will be dropped off at "doors open" pre-show. They will perform at the end of the first half and will be ready for collection at the end of interval. This allows them to watch the second half with their parents or guardian .



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DROP OFF AND PICK UP

Students will be signed into the venue upon arrival by their responsible parent or guardian and will be supervised through the duration of photos, rehearsal and show by staff and helpers. Students cannot leave the premises without being signed out by a parent or guardian. If your child has any Medical Conditions that may require attention whilst in our care or are carrying any medication with them, please notify our supervisors when you sign in. Please be on time (early!), as we have a tight schedule to stick to. VPC staff will have a copy of your contact numbers (provided on your registration) on hand if we need to contact you.

BACKSTAGE

Only the VPC assigned staff and registered parent helpers are permitted backstage. We are unable to run messages or food to dancers, so please make sure that they have everything before they come backstage for rehearsal and the show.

We do not allow parents or guardians to enter the backstage area or auditorium while the students are rehearsing on stage or getting ready. It is also important for fire safety that we keep extra numbers to a minimum. Each group will be assigned a grown up helper to be backstage. We only have each class scheduled in the auditorium and on stage for a short period of time and need to make sure that the dancers are focused. We love to surprise everyone with how spectacular these dancers are in the show, so no peaking allowed!

VOLUNTEERS/HELPERS

These types of events wouldn't be possible without our community. We need you! A few parents for each age group is ideal. If you have concerns about your dancer backstage, sign up as a helper! It is important that you do this BEFORE the event taking place. You can sign up via the show registration form. Let us know your availability and you will be assigned to tasks for photo day, rehearsals and/or show day.

SEWING BEE

Want to help out but can't commit to the show days or rehearsals? How about lending a hand at our sewing bees! No sewing experience necessary. There is plenty to cut, glue, tag, sort, etc! Sign up via the QR code.





PHOTOS VIDEOS AND PERFORMANCE FEE

PHOTOS & VIDEOS

We want you to enjoy the LIVE experience and not miss anything behind a camera so we have arranged professional services to do this for you.

For copyright and child safety reasons, we do not allow any photographs to be taken during the show by anyone other than our contracted photographer. There is to be no private photography of the show or photo sessions!

The show will be filmed, edited and uploaded to a secure website where you can stream online or download at your leisure. The photos and video are already included in your 'Performance Fee' added to your Jackrabbit Portal. See more information about this below.

We can not guarantee that your child will get an onstage photo despite us doing our best to capture every smiling face. That is why it's so important to attend our photo day.



PERFORMANCE FEE

The performance fee will be posted in two parts to your Jackrabbit Portal. Please make the first payment by Nov 6th and second payment by Nov 17th (along with your tuition fees).

What this fee covers:

The cost of hireage of your costumes (designing, sourcing, creating, sizing, cleaning, storing etc.) including accessories and hairpieces.

Access to a secure website to view and download ALL professional photographs of the backstage and on stage rehearsals and the show.

Access to a secure website to stream and download professionally edited video footage of the show. As well as the additional rehearsal and teacher costs required for a show,

No refunds are given if a parent or guardian withdraws a child from the school/from the show after this fee has been paid, as costumes are prepaid to our suppliers by the dance school. The payment of this fee shows your commitment to the above stated dates and requirements in this handbook.

If your tuition fees and/or performance fees are not up-todate, your child will not be allowed to perform on stage.

COSTUMES, MAKEUP & CLASSES

COSTUMES

A costume list for each class has been attached to the handbook. This will include hair style, and what extras are required in addition to the costume supplied: i.e. underwear, socks, singlets, shorts, t-shirts. Costume fittings will be done before/during/following dance classes in the lead up to the show. Hence consistent attendance is really important to ensure your child goes on stage with a costume!

MAKEUP AND HAIR

We have volunteers that will assist with SOME hair, makeup and special effects. However this year we ask that students put their hair in a style (per costume list) and apply stage makeup before they arrive for both the photo day and the show. If you can't do the desired style, please send your dancer with their makeup kit, hairbrush, hair ties, gel, hairspray, bobby pins and hairnet so someone backstage can do it for them. Don't wash your dancer's hair on the day of or the day before the show. We have a basic makeup and hair kit for sale through VPC. Check our uniform/merchandise order form.

REGULAR CLASSES

To ensure that the dancers feel confident about their performance, dancers must continue to attend class regularly. Also, we ask parents and guardians to encourage them to practice their choreography at home on a regular basis, videos will also be posted via the Jackrabbit Portal Resources.

In terms of attendance, it is very important that dancers do not miss any of their scheduled classes between now and show time so they can spend their rehearsal time together to perform their routines, feel confident and look amazing. If your child is sick/injured for class but well enough to watch, we can arrange a zoom link. If for any reason your child will miss any of their regular classes, we ask that you submit their absence via the Jackrabbit Portal. Please note that unfortunately any families with unpaid dance or performance fees will not be allowed to participate in our show.

DRESS REHEARSAL SATURDAY 25TH NOVEMBER

It will give the students the opportunity to "watch" their peers as they won't be able to do this on show day.




